Here are a few questions that we get asked quite a bit:

What GPA do I need to get into Iowa BIG?

We do not filter applicants by GPA. Our current enrollment has a GPA range of 1.5 to 4.3.

What is the time requirement?

Most student enroll in three *consecutive* periods of their day, although some students attend their entire day at Iowa BIG. Project requirements are not balanced day-to-day, which helps students practice time management skills.

Where are you located?

BIG has two main campuses: one in Cedar Rapids' NewBo District and another on Boyson Road near C Ave; however, students spend large amounts of time embedded with their projects' partners, which may be somewhere else in the city.

I don't have a car, how can I get to meetings all over the city?

We have grants that pay for taxis and buses.

Do I need to have a project/initiative in mind before I enroll?

Nope. We employ amazing personnel who harvest projects year-round from businesses, non-profits, and government agencies; although we'd love to hear your idea!

What will my transcript look like?

Just like a student's who attended 100% of their time at one of the high schools. Our credits are conferred by the student's parent high school.

What's the student body like?

In 2017-2018, Iowa BIG's student body of ~210 students will be: 34% CRCSD, 32% CCSD, 30% Linn-Mar, 2% Marion ISD, and 2% Mount Vernon students.
